

July 8, 2010 – Salesian GHQ – Choosing the logo for the Project Europe



(ANS – Rome) – On the eve of the next meeting of the Commission for Project Europe, scheduled for July 16-18 at Czestochowa, Poland, the SDB Communications Department is seeking opinions about the proposals sent in for this important process which the Salesian Congregation officially launched in 2009.

At the end of March the department appealed to Salesian creativity in the production of a logo for Project Europe. Some suggestions have arrived in the ANS offices which will now be considered by the Commission and a choice made. Among those submitted are some from pupils at the Salesian School in Chertsey who, at the suggestion of Fr. Andrew Ebrahim, have sent in their ideas.

One may see the contributions submitted by going to the appropriate **section** opened on Agorà on the sdb.org site. To express one's own preference before Thursday, July 15, just log in on the site, where it is possible to vote for one of the proposals. The results of the sample survey will be taken to Czestochowa and will assist the members of the Commission in selecting their short list. It will then be up to the Rector Major and his council to make the final choice.
